General Storage conditions

To avoid heat and moisture damage to packed glass, the following conditions for storage of the packed units must be adhered to.

A. Storage in rooms

1. The packages themselves must stand on solid, level ground.
2. The packages must not be allowed to stand in exposed areas and that no direct sunlight falls on the packages.
3. High levels of long-term moisture must not be allowed to occur on the glass units.

The room should have sufficient ventilation.

B. Storage outside

If it is not possible to store the glass inside then the following must also be complied with:

1. A waterproof cover must be positioned over the units so that they do not stand in direct sunlight and that the cover has sufficient ventilation at the sides to avoid heat build-up.
2. The cover should be wide enough to ensure that no driving rain can hit the units.

Packaging of glass may be:

- Returnable stillages
- One-way stillages
- Wooden crates
